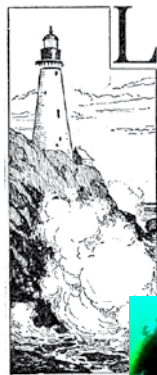

Choose from three 2-day mini-camps about life as a lighthouse inkeeper, shipwrecks of the Great Lakes and Victorian games & Pastimes.

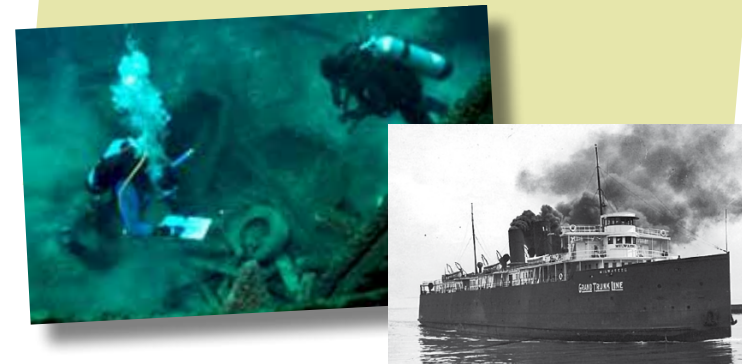
### North Point Lighthouse KEEPER'S CAMP

Discover the importance of lighthouses as an important aid to maritime navigation and how lighthouse illumination works through our original Fresnel lens! Learn and experiment with the science of how light is bent with a prism. Roleplay the life of a lighthouse keeper. Climb the 84 steps of the 1888 lighthouse tower and tour the keeper's quarters to learn how keepers performed their duties to ensure ship's safety. Become a Junior Lighthouse Keeper! Build your own model lighthouse that lights up and write your own keeper's log. Finally, create a dramatic presentation of a day in the life of a keeper and present to your family and friends!

Discover the mysteries of shipwrecks of Lake Michigan! Learn the science and social science of underwater archaeology and the work of divers and their discoveries. See, touch and try out some of the equipment that underwater archaeologists use. Hear a story and learn about the life and work of keeper Martin Knudsen and his important lifesaving work during the shipwrecks along the coast of Door County, Wisconsin. Climb the lighthouse tower and hear how keepers prevented shipwrecks. Reconstruct how two ships sank in Lake Michigan – the SS Milwaukee and the SS Wisconsin. Experiment with science objects and techniques regarding our lakes. Create and practice an oral, written and visual presentation on one of these wrecks.

For all sessions, campers should wear comfortable clothes and closed-toe shoes. Bring a snack lunch and a water bottle.
